Riverstone Transit Center

Located in Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, the Riverstone Transit Center brings administrative staff and bus services for City Link and Paratransit together in a central location.

The 2,500-square-foot administrative building has offices, driver break room, training room, dispatch and storage. There are outdoor public restrooms and a covered waiting shelter.

The site has landscaped pathways to each of the eight bus loading areas, as well as 80 parking stalls and additional space for future growth.
